Hato Schmeiser (born 1968) studied business administration at the University of Mannheim and received his doctorate in solvency measurement in 1997. After two years in reinsurance practice at ERC Frankona in Munich, he continued his academic work at the Humboldt University of Berlin, where he obtained his habilitation in 2003. From 2003 onward, he held a chair in insurance management at the University of Münster. Since 2005, Hato Schmeiser has been a full professor of business administration with a focus on risk management at the University of St. Gallen. He also serves as Managing Director of the Institute of Insurance Economics (IVW-HSG). His research and consulting focuses on the financial management of insurance companies, solvency measurement issues, and retirement provision. His academic work has been recognized by the American Risk and Insurance Association (ARIA) (RMIR Best Paper Award 2005 and 2008), the American Actuarial Association (CAS) (2009), the Journal of Risk Finance (Outstanding Paper Award, Emerald Literati Network 2013; Highly Commended Paper Award 2018), and the Journal of Insurance Issues (Best Paper Award JII/CSIR 2014). Since 2019, Hato Schmeiser has been a member of the board of the American Risk and Insurance Association (ARIA). He served as Vice Dean of the School of Management at the University of St.Gallen until 2023, and as President of the Executive Committees of the Institute of Business Administration and the Institute of Information Systems until 2024.
